



Dear Parents

We are proud to share that our setting has been donated a LifeVac anti-choking device by The Oliver Steeper Foundation. This remarkable charity was founded in memory of baby Oliver Steeper, who tragically passed away in September 2021 following a choking incident at a nursery in Ashford, Kent. His parents, Lewis and Zoe, have turned their heartbreak into hope by creating a lasting legacy: fundraising to provide a LifeVac kit to every Ofsted-registered childcare setting in Kent and across the United Kingdom.

So far, the Foundation has donated over 1,410 LifeVac devices to nurseries, preschools, and childminders. Each LifeVac Kit, costing between £65–£85, provides peace of mind, can save a life in a choking emergency and offers an extra layer of reassurance for families and practitioners alike when first aid fails or cannot be performed as per MHRA guidance.

It's important to remember that LifeVac does not replace first aid. First aid protocols must always be followed. However, if first aid fails or cannot be performed in a choking emergency, LifeVac can be deployed safely.

As of October 2025, LifeVac has been directly credited with saving over 4,820 lives worldwide, including more than 2,890 children. It is fully regulated by leading medical device authorities including the MHRA (UK), FDA (USA), TGA (Australia), and many others. It also carries CE registration and has passed all NHS clinical validations. Peer-reviewed studies confirm its safety, effectiveness, ease of use, and life-saving capability.

Free CPD certified e-learning is available via their website, every kit comes with a detailed instruction booklet and a QR code which takes everyone to a free training video.

If a LifeVac is used, reporting its use via www.lifevac.uk ensures the device and masks are replaced free of charge.
